- Paonia River Park Western Slope Conservation Center
  - Local access to the North Fork of the Gunnison
- Orvis Hot Springs
  - Developed hot springs, people go from all over, 90m drive
- Penny Hot Springs
  - Natural hot springs off the side of 133 in the Crystal River, 70m drive.
- Grand Mesa
  - Popular and unique area for all kinds of outdoor fun
- Jumbo Mountain Trailhead
  - Paonia's access to lots of BLM trails, is high-desert terrain, a mile from downtown
- Black Canyon of the Gunnison
  - Maybe cooler and definitely less of an ordeal than the Grand Canyon. 40m drive.
- <u>Colorado National Monument (U.S. National Park Service)</u>
  - Another great spot! 1.75hr drive
